Traditionally this was the time of year for the Nyoongar people to migrate inland. Food consisted of fattier red-meat animals; the yonga (kangaroo) and weitj (emu) were hunted at this time of year and used as bookas (food and clothing) to help ward off the cold.

Swans return to the lake and here at Lake Gwelup the rising lake levels are welcomed.
